

What is FERPA?

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA) protects the privacy of student records by requiring prior written **consent** before disclosing personally identifiable information to a **third party**.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Each student attending classes at Emory has these rights, regardless of age. Parents controlled these rights during their student's high school career.
- FERPA gives students the right to inspect their educational records. They have ownership of these rights as long as they live.
- Students may complete a **FERPA Consent Form** to release information to other individuals. *More on this later!*





What do I have access to?

(No consent form required.)

BASIC INFORMATION

- Whether or not a student is enrolled
- Address
- Telephone Number

ACADEMIC INFORMATION

- School/Division and class/year
- Dates of enrollment, including full-time/ part-time status
- Degrees earned and date
- Major Area of Concentration

EXTRA INFORMATION

- Academic honors received
- Awards of merit
- Participation in officially recognized activities and sports



Consent Forms: What do they cover?

Your student may complete a FERPA Consent Form.


This form allows them to list specific individuals who have permission to receive more academic information. Information about or related to academic life at Emory.

General advisory letters based on academic performance.

Authorization for the Dean of Emory College of Arts and Sciences (or a representative) to discuss academic performance with those listed.

Copy of any notification regarding academic probation or exclusion from the college.

How do I access the form?






Additional Access

Students have the option to grant up to 5 Guest Access accounts.

- The **student** will create an account for each guest and have the option to allow what guests can see or what function guests can access.
- The student has the option to delete or add any guest they wish at any time.

Helping Your Student "Adult"
